Statement of Modification

- 1. This Statement of Modification sets out the changes to the Draft Charging Schedule since it was published in accordance with Regulation 16 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended).
- 2. As required under Regulation 19, a copy of this Statement of Modification has been sent to each person previously invited to make representations on the Draft Charging Schedule under Regulation 15 and has been published on the Council's website. This Statement of Modification will also be made available at the Council's offices and in libraries across the District for inspection during business hours.


Requests to be heard


- 7. Any person may request to be heard by the Examiner in relation to the modification set out in this Statement of Modifications. This right applies only to this modification.
