DECISION REGARDING DESIGNATION OF WHITCHURCH ON THAMES AS A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA UNDER SECTION 61G OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 AS AMENDED

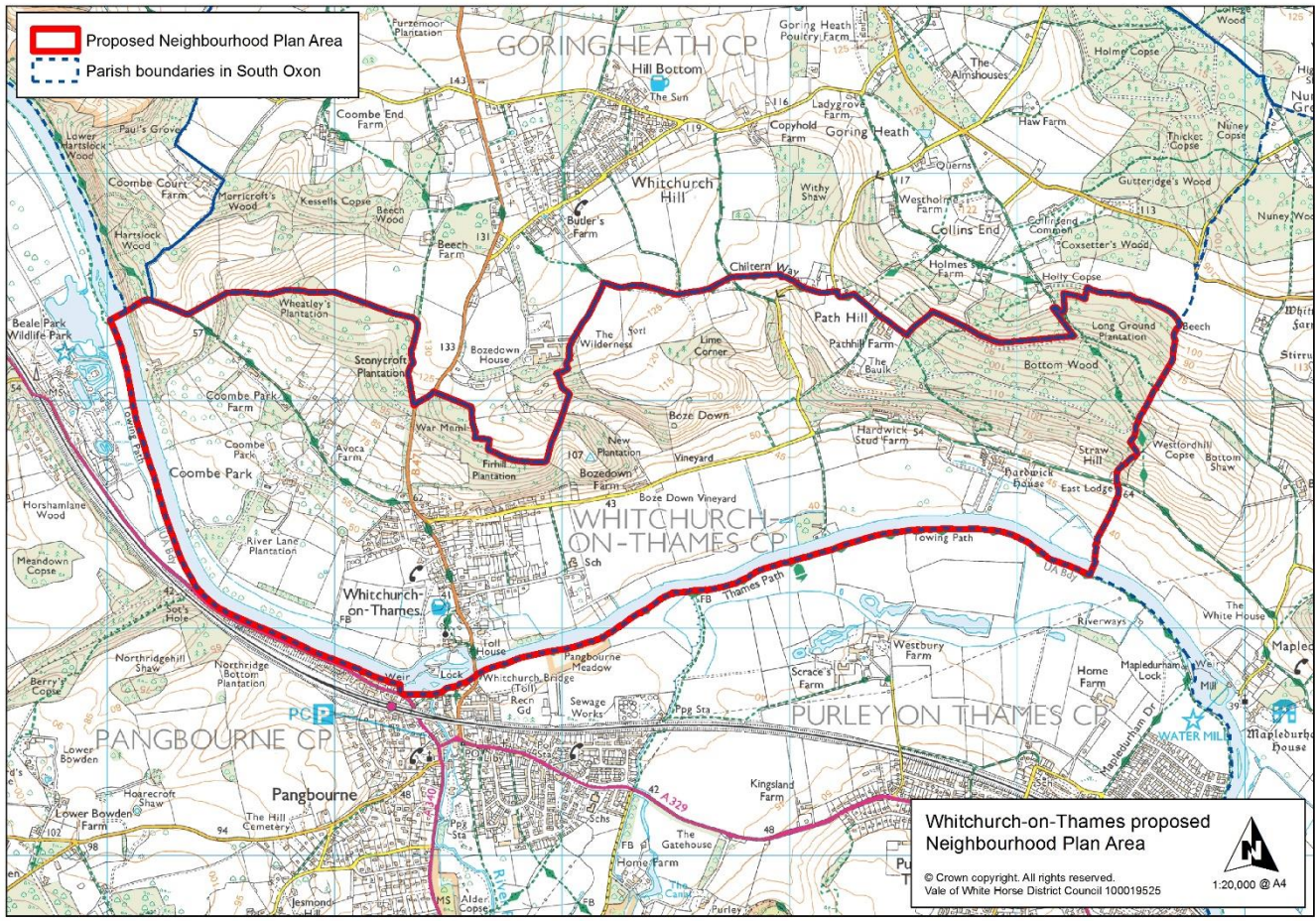
This letter confirms that on 24 August 2016, the Head of Planning at South Oxfordshire District Council, designated the area shown in Appendix 1 below as the 'Whitchurch on Thames Neighbourhood Plan Area'. This designation has been made for the purposes of preparing a Neighbourhood Development Plan by Whitchurch on Thames Parish Council under section 61G(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended. It was decided not to designate the area as a business area under section 61H(1) of the Act as it is not primarily or wholly business in nature.
