## DECISION REGARDING DESIGNATION OF HORSPATH AS A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA UNDER SECTION 61G OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 AS AMENDED

This letter confirms that on 24 August 2016, the Head of Planning at South Oxfordshire District Council, designated the area shown in Appendix 1 below as the 'Horspath Neighbourhood Plan Area'. - c) Relevant body: Horspath Parish Council


