

Duty to refer – advice for agencies helping people at risk of homelessness

for the South Oxfordshire and Vale of White Horse Districts







Duty to refer

Under the Homelessness Reduction Act 2017, certain public agencies have a duty to refer households they believe are either homeless or at risk of homelessness.

These agencies are:

Prisons
Young Offender Institutions
Secure training centres
Secure colleges

Youth offending teams

Probation services (including community rehabilitation companies)

Jobcentres in England

Social service authorities (both adult and children's)

Hospital emergency departments

Urgent treatment centres

Hospitals in their function of providing inpatient care

Secretary of State for Defence in relation to members of the regular armed forces

We encourage all partner agencies to let us know as soon as possible if they believe a household needs our help.

If you work for a partner agency, you can register and then refer to our Housing Options team below:

You must have your client's permission to make a referral.

We will attempt to contact the person within 10 working days to verify their circumstances. We will also inform you whether we were able to make contact.
