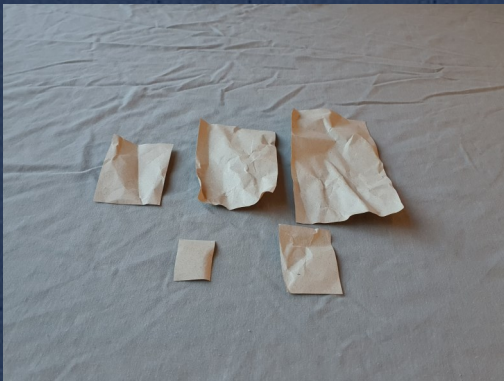


Tutorial guide for decorative Christmas wrapping



You will need: some old paper (newspaper, tissue paper, brown paper etc.), glue, scissors and an old Christmas card—and a wrapped gift!



Cut several (at least four) rectangles from the paper each one smaller than the last.



Take one piece and fold it in half vertically.



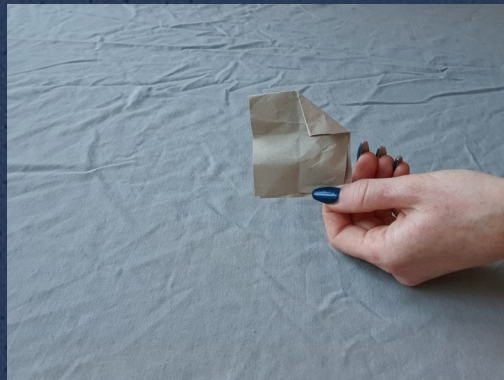
Then fold that in half horizontally.



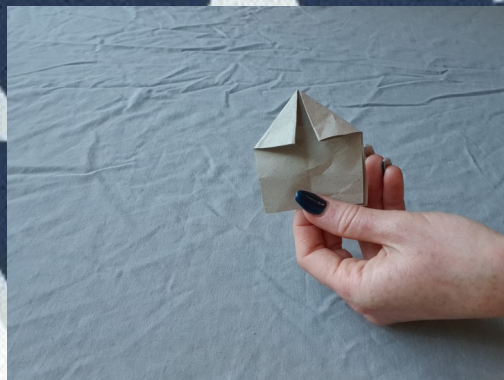
Repeat on all pieces so they look like this.



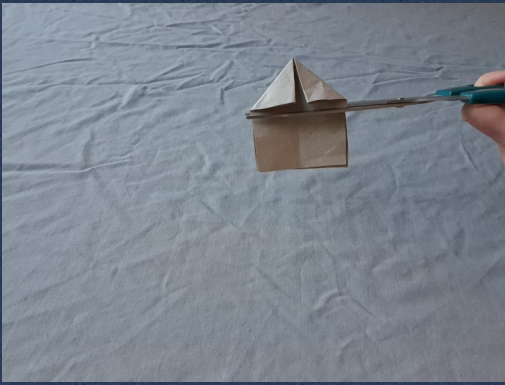
Take a piece.



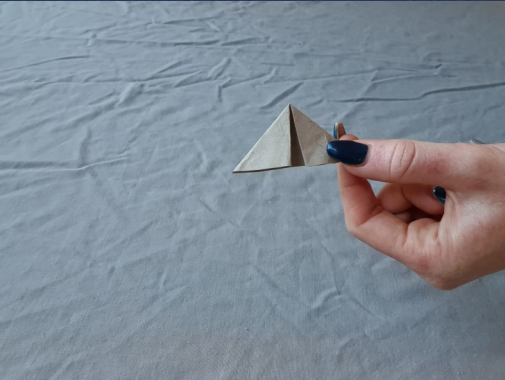
Fold over a top corner (the top is the folded edge) so it meets the middle line.



Repeat with the other corner.



Cut off the excess paper beneath the triangle.



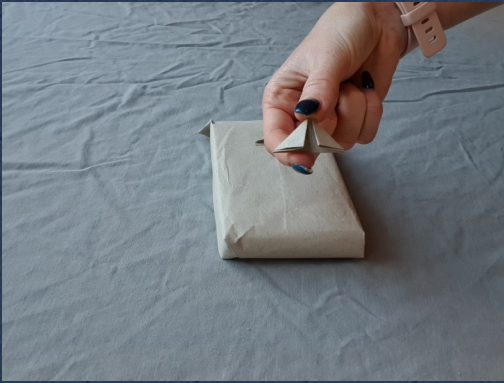
Repeat with all pieces until they all look like this.



Take your gift.



Get your glue ready.



Take the smallest one of your triangles.



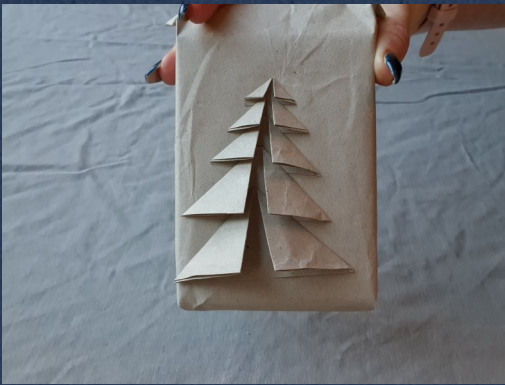
Turn it over so the folded side faces away from you, apply glue and stick it near the top of your gift.



Repeat with the next size up and glue it below the smallest triangle, with the tip of the triangle slightly overlapping the edge of the smaller one, underneath the folds as shown in the picture.



It will look like this.



Repeat with all triangles until they look like this. You now have a Christmas tree! You can decorate this by drawing a stump and lights using colouring pens.



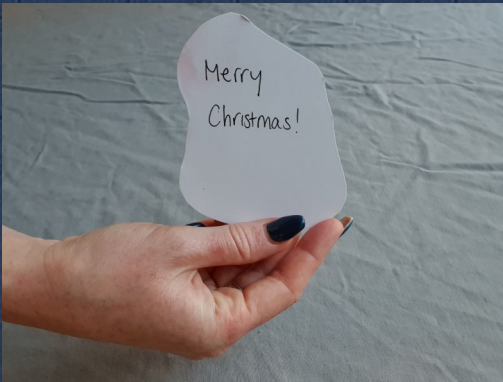
Cut the front off your old Christmas card.



Cut around the design.



This can be any shape.



Write your message.



Fix to your gift. It's now ready to go under the tree!
