Kidmore End Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan – South Oxfordshire District Council response to Examiner’s Clarification Note of 11th October 2021

In your clarification note dated 11 October 2021 you raised the following points for the District Council to address:

Whilst looking at the proposed housing site off Tokers Green Lane in Kidmore End, I saw the Natural England notice about the ‘footpath’ in the field. I also saw the well-defined pathway running to the south and west from that point.

What is the status (if any) of the pathway running through the field of which the proposed housing site is a part?

I saw the site notice in Coopers Pightle for the planning application on land between Coopers Pightle and Butlers Orchard (P21/S3391/O).

Is there a timetable for the determination of the planning application?

We contacted Oxfordshire County Council and they have confirmed that no public right of way is recorded in this location off Tokers Green lane, opposite Butlers Orchard, but that is without prejudice to any unrecorded rights.

Information regarding public rights of way can be accessed from the Oxfordshire County Council website, legal changes made to the network and the definitive map since 2006 are shown on the interactive countryside map, which is available [here](#).

In terms of the anticipated timescale for the determination of planning application P21/S3391/O at land between Coopers Pightle and Butlers Orchard, the application is still under consideration. The target date for a decision is the 29th November 2021. More information about the planning application can be found on our planning application register, [link here](#).
