I am writing following the Secretary of State's announcement of my appointment as interim Chair of the Office for Local Government (Oflog), and the letter to you from the Minister for Local Government.

As the Minister said in his letter, Oflog has the objective of highlighting the work of local government, shining a light on excellence and providing data about the performance of authorities.
