

	<p>Fuel Poverty and Warm Homes grants - A grant of £1,000 for energy-saving repairs and home improvements, including insulation, for homeowners or private tenants who receive qualifying benefits or meet other criteria. To apply, please visit the Better Housing Better Health website or call 0800 107 0044.</p>
	<p>Cosy Homes Oxfordshire - If you are looking to invest in your home, Cosy Homes is a paid-for service that can offer expert advice and project management to guide you through the retrofitting process. 	<p>Boiler Upgrade Scheme - Eligible homeowners can get a grant of up to £7,500 towards replacing oil, gas or electric heating with a heat pump or biomass boiler. To apply, please visit the Boiler Upgrade Scheme website or call 0330 053 2006.</p>
	<p>Great British Insulation Scheme - Grants for insulation, new heating systems and solar panels, for homeowners or private tenants who receive qualifying benefits. To apply, please visit the Better Housing Better Health website or call 0800 107 0044.</p>
	<p>Essential Housing Repair grant - A grant of up to £10,000 for repairs, insulation and other energy-saving improvements, for homeowners who have lived in their house for 3+ years and receive qualifying benefits. To apply, please email psh@southandvale.gov.uk or call 01235 422436.</p>
	<p>Home Upgrade Grant - This is for homes not heated by gas. The grant will pay for insulation, air source heat pumps and solar panels for homeowners and private tenants in homes with low energy efficiency ratings with an income of under £39,000 or who receive qualifying benefits.
