NOTICE OF PROPOSAL SOUTH OXFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)(NO.1) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that South Oxfordshire District Council (the Council) proposes to make the above Order under Sections 32, 33(4) and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act), Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act and the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to regulate the use of and set the tariff of charges to be made at the Council's off street car parks.

The Order contains various provisions concerning enforcement with regard to the operation of the car parks and enforcement in relation to payment of charges and other conditions of use.

The Council proposes:

- a) to revoke The South Oxfordshire District Council (Off-Street Parking Places)(No.1) Order 2022;
- b) to make the South Oxfordshire District Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places)(No.1) Order 2024;
- c) to introduce a new charging regime in Goldsmiths Lane car park, Wallingford by extending the current charging periods from 9am to 5pm to 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday and charging on Sunday 10am to 5pm;
- d) to introduce paid parking permits for those car parks that currently have no charge.

The proposed changes and other conditions of use of the car parks are set out in the Schedule below. These changes are specifically described in the draft proposed Order, along with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, which will be available for inspection at the Council office at Abbey House, Abbey Close, Abingdon OX14 3JE between 9:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday 25 March to Friday 19 April 2024 (not including bank holidays).
